RWA is presently defending proceedings by Ms Thomas in the Industrial Magistrates Court, in which she is claiming long service leave.

The Board and senior staff of RWA are continuing to assist the Department of Energy, Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety (DEMIRS) with their investigation of matters under Ms Thomas' leadership. The Board has accepted the appointment of a Supervisor by DEMIRS in relation to a remedial plan to regularise the affairs of RWA.
